<p>Washington received Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funding for Adult, Dislocated Worker, and Youth programs that provide employment counseling, work experience, and work readiness and occupational training. Most of these funds are passed through to 12 Workforce Development Councils that operate local WIOA programs. Recipients of public assistance and other low-income individuals are priority recipients of Adult funds. Dislocated Worker funds go toward providing services and education that most efficiently and effectively help dislocated workers and veterans obtain employment. The majority of Youth funds will be used to operate work experiences throughout the year that introduce youth to the rigors, demands, rewards, and sanctions associated with holding a job. WIOA training services may include: occupational skills training; on-the-job training; and programs that combine workplace training with related instruction, including registered apprenticeships, training programs operated by the private sector, skill upgrade and retaining, entrepreneurship training, adult education and literacy training, and customized training.</p>
