Purpose:

To communicate revision of the WorkSource Services Catalog, which reflects services available under Titles I and III of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) of 2014 and Subchapter B, Part II of the Trade Act of 1974 as amended, as well as services supporting various WorkSource programs.

Action Required:

Local Workforce Development Boards and their contractors, as well as Employment Security Regional Directors, must distribute this guidance broadly throughout the system to ensure that WorkSource System staff are familiar with its content and requirements.

Content:

Change 16 reflects the relabeling of the "State EcSA Services" tab to "State-Funded Services", as well as the relabeling of its contained services from "State EcSA" to "State-Funded". These changes allow services to be associated with and tracked in ETO by various grants or state programs that are not funded by WIOA or Wagner-Peyser.

One additional state-funded service has been added to the "State-Funded Services" tab that is unique to the Community Reinvestment Fund:

• "Community Reinvestment Financial Support Payments" - Incentive payments provided by the Community Reinvestment Fund for participants.

Additionally, the Worksource Service Catalog now serves as the sole reference for state-funded services (concurrent with Change 3 to WIN 0129, State Guidance and Instructions for the State EcSA Program).
