SUBJECT:	: Notice of Upcoming Changes to CASAS Testing Materials Used to Determine Basic Skills Deficiency for Enrollment in WIOA Title I Programs.	

Purpose:

To communicate upcoming changes to allowable CASAS assessments and testing materials and upcoming training on the new assessments and materials and to further communicate that ESD's Employment System Administration and Policy team is in the process of revising WorkSource System Policy 1011 on the use of CASAS for basic skills assessment to align with these changes.

Action Required:

Local Workforce Development Boards and their contractors, as well as Employment Security Regional Directors, must distribute this guidance broadly throughout the system to ensure that WorkSource System staff are familiar with its content and requirements.

Content:

The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) has notified ESD that some of the allowable CASAS assessments are changing effective July 1, 2019.

Current assessments permitted for use through June 30, 2019 (see <u>WorkSource System Policy 1011</u> <u>Revision 4</u>)	The <u>only</u> assessments permitted for use beginning July 1, 2019
Life and Work Reading (forms 81-188)	CASAS Reading GOALS series
Life and Work Listening (forms 981-986)	No change to Life and Work Listening
Life Skills Math (forms 31-38)	CASAS Math GOALS series
	Appraisal (Form 900) *new*
Score needed to qualify as Basic Skills Deficient (BSD): under 236	Score needed to qualify as BSD: 238 or less
