SUBJECT: Distribution of Fiscal Year 2016 Rapid Response funds to local areas to increase Fiscal Year 2016 WIOA Dislocated Worker program allotments

Purpose:

To communicate the State's formula allocation of \$2.5 million in Fiscal Year 2016 (FY16) Rapid Response funds to increase local area FY16 WIOA Title I-B Dislocated Worker allotments.

Action Required:

Modified FY16 WIOA Title I-B Dislocated Worker and Administrative Cost Pool (ACP) grants were issued to each Local Workforce Development Board (LWDB) on April 6, 2016. LWDBs were instructed to complete the packages and e-mail signed grant modifications to Donna Fussell in the Workforce and Career Development Division's WIOA Grants Administration Unit for processing.

Content:

The State formula allocated \$2.5 million in FY16 State Rapid Response funds to increase local area FY16 WIOA Title I-B Dislocated Worker formula allotments. Per the WIOA Dislocated Worker formula methodology reflected in [WIOA Title I Policy 5270](#), additional program and ACP allotments and subsequently revised program and ACP allotments were as follows:
