Notice to Veterans and Eligible Spouses

Did you know about priority of service?

<u>Priority of service</u> means you are a prioritized customer. As a veteran or eligible spouse, you can get priority access to WorkSource services, including priority referrals to jobs that are listed on WorkSource, as well as other employment and training programs!

WorkSource centers offer <u>veterans and their eligible</u> <u>spouses</u>:

- Job listings, job referrals and hiring events.
- Resume, application and interviewing assistance.
- Use of computers, photocopiers and phones.
- Skill assessments and referrals to training and other resources.

You are eligible for priority service if:

- You left Active Duty US military service or were a member of the National Guard activated to federal Service under title 10, and did not receive a dishonorable discharge.
- You are the spouse of a U.S. military veteran who:
 - Died as the result of a service-related disability; or
 - Is reported as missing in action or a prisoner of war; or
 - Has been forcibly detained or interned in the line of duty by a foreign government or power for more than 90 days; or
 - Has a total, permanent disability resulting from military service.
